At Wolvey C of E Primary we aim to put the children's own learning at the centre of the curriculum that we offer. We recognise the importance of making children's learning memorable and meaningful and we do this mainly through a themed based approach which enables children to make connections and link ideas and areas of learning. We provide a broad and balanced curriculum which often sees the children working beyond the classroom, whether it is in the school's wildlife area, across classes on a particular project or with the local community. Our aim at Wolvey is to excite our children about learning; to give them an appreciation that learning is a life-long, daily process that can make a genuine difference to their lives as children and as adults.

Welfare

At Wolvey C of E Primary School, we regard the safeguarding and the welfare of our children as our main priority. We believe that we all have the right to be happy, to be safe and to learn. We all have the responsibility to make this happen. We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expect all staff, volunteers and other third parties to share this commitment. The safety of our pupils is our number one priority. We have 3 members of staff who are Designated Safe Guarding leads and all the staff are trained in child protection. Children at Wolvey feel safe and are taught how to keep themselves safe in the wider community and online.

Pastoral Care

at our School



We are very proud of the level of pastoral care at Wolvey C of E Primary School and we firmly believe that for our pupils this is paramount to ensure success. The whole school works as a team to ensure that this is achieved. Strong positive partnerships between home and school are essential – working together is key.

We have a team of staff who monitor and provide support to children whether it is for emotional, behavioural or self-esteem/confidence challenges. We have good links with external support and recognise the impact and importance of experts on a child's journey.

We also provide extra support for children of military families and have a Service Children's mentor who, with other staff, provides additional pastoral support and organises different events for both children and their parents.

Extra-Curricular Activities

at our School

At Wolvey though English and Maths are the central ingredients of our curriculum we believe that children should have the opportunity to shine in other areas, whether these are within the school day or as an extra-curricular activity.

Children have the opportunity to take up music lessons in violin or guitar and join the school choir.

Experiencing a range of different sports is our aim. In school time children mainly in Year 3 and 4 attend swimming sessions and after school clubs include dancing, badminton and dodge ball. Children can also compete in football, netball and other disciplines against local schools.

Older children can attend a residential where they experience all sorts of challenges from high wires to rafting. This promotes a new found confidence and a sense of independence.

We also make good use of our school grounds with the children encouraged to explore all the open spaces and our wildlife area.
